Background

- In continuation of national response to climate change, some line ministries have prepared sectoral climate change strategies
- The development of the climate change action plan and the costing of the actions is the next step in the process in order to operationalize the strategy.
- The Council of Ministers provided outlines for preparing policy, strategic and action plans.
- Building on the strategic planning process, Climate Change Department (CCD) will provide guidance and support the development of the action plans




Approach to the Action Planning Process

- The climate change action plan is not meant to be 'a standalone' set of actions
- Integrated into regular actions carried out by the line ministries.
- Working closely with the Planning Department of the ministries
- Mapping climate change actions to Public Investment Plans (PIP), Budget Strategic Plan (BSP), and regular annual work plan of line ministries.
- Build capacity of sectors to ensure that climate change is systematically considered in the planning of future projects (for example through climate change screening procedures for new projects)
- Stakeholders are engaged in the process

Key Sections of the Action Plan

- A. Strategies
- B. Action Plan
 - Summary of scope of planning
 - ii. Action Plan Matrix
 - iii. Expected benefits from the implementation of the Action Plan
- C. Management and Financing Mechanisms
 - i. Analysis of existing management & financing mechanisms
 - ii. Analysis of potential sources & volume of finance for climate change actions
 - iii. Mainstreaming in management & financing mechanisms
- D. Monitoring and Evaluation
- E. Law and Regulation drafting schedule



Support from the Climate Change Department

Two types of support will be provided to line ministries:

- a) Cash Support
 - Overall facilitation of the exercise (e.g. internal meetings, stakeholders consultations etc.)
 - Drafting of the action plan
- b) In-kind Supports (Technical Experts)
 - Sector Experts (3)
 - Experts providing cross-cutting support (6)
 - M & E Expert (1)
 - Information & Knowledge Management (1)

•	Institutional analyses & prioritization	20 August - 20 Sept 2013
•	Drafting the CCAP	20–30 September 2013
-	Technical Review by CCD & National Climate Change Committee (NCCC)	1 – 15 October 2013
-	Final version and endorsement by the line ministries	15 – 31 October 2013
•	Launch	Nov or Dec 2013

Expected Outputs

- I. A climate change action plan with costing of the priority actions for the nine line ministries
- II. A guideline for the preparation of the CCAP and CCFF
- III. Integration of climate change actions in the regular ministry programming process (PIP, BSP, annual work plan)
