Type of support required

- Analysis: mostly refer to sectoral CCSPs
- Other elements of the action plan wich may require support:
 - Identifying relevant actions and prioritizing
 - Facilitating consultations as part of prioritization process
 - Costing
 - Identifying potential sources of funding and funding mechanisms
 - Identifying mechanisms for continuous CC mainstreaming in plans/programmes



Available support from MoE

- Consultations /workshops: a small cash allocation will be available to each ministry to organize consultations with concerned stakholders (internal or external)
- In-kind advisory support: MoE/CCD is putting together a team of experts and consultants. Some will provide crosscutting advice, and some will be assigned to support 2 to 3 ministries specifically.
- Other sources of support may be available from your own ministry



Next steps for action plan

Timeline	Step
May	Senior Minister/MoE writes to ministers, acknowledging CCSP development and presenting process for CC action plan
May-June	Discussions and approval of Letter of Agreement with each ministry/agency. Draft guidelines shared.
June- early July	Finalization of guidelines for action plan development, followed by training workshop
June-early July	Provision of cash support + consultants made available
July-October	Development of action plans

Immediate next steps for line ministries

On the NSDP submission process

- Indicate if support is required from MoE/CCD to draft or review the Climate Change content of their ministry's submission to MoP
- Suggest some CC-related indicators for their ministry (send your proposals to CCD by 26 May for review)

On the Action Plan process

- Start identifying who should be involved in the action plan development process, both internally (including planning department) and externally (other stakeholders)
- When relevant consult with Department of Planning and inform them about the need to integrate CC actions in the ministry's PIP or annual work plan

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
