Approaching the CC Action Plan

- The climate change action plan is not meant to be 'a standalone' set of actions
- They should be integrated into the regular actions carried out by the line ministries.
- Working closely with the Department of Planning in relevant ministries
- This will be achieved by identifying climate change actions and mapping these actions to Private Investment Plan (PIP) and regular annual work plan of the line ministries.
- Building capacity of sectors to ensure that climate change is systematically considered in the planning of future projects (for example through climate change screening procedures for new projects)

Expected Output

I. A climate change action plan for the concerned sector(s)

II. Integration of climate change actions in the regular ministry programming process (PIP, Budget Stratgic Plan, annual work plan)
